

2011 IWGA Championship Schedule Release...

With 2010 being the first year the Iowa Women's Golf Association has awarded a Player of the Year, Senior Player of the Year, and a Junior Player of the Year, the IWGA is anxious to announce the sites for the 2011 IWGA Championships.

After hosting the Iowa Women's Amateur in 1995, Sunnyside Country Club in Waterloo will be the venue for 2011 Women's Amateur July 25 - 27. Sunnyside Country Club is a very historical and prestigious course, which have made it an excellent championship style course that will be a test for amateur women's golfers.

The Iowa Senior Women's Amateur Championship will be held at The Preserve on Rathbun Lake in Moravia, June 20 - 21. This will be the first year The Preserve has hosted an IWGA Championship. The Preserve opened in 2008 and is a beautiful site for the Senior Women's Amateur.

The 2nd Women's Four-Ball Championship will be held at the newly re-designed Otter Creek Golf Course in Ankeny on August 7 - 8. The par-71 Paul Miller design will be a great host for this new team event.

Additional hosts for IWGA Championships will be Lake Panorama National Resort (Iowa Junior Girls'; June 13 - 14), Jester Park Golf Course (Father-Son and Parent-Child), Ames Golf and Country Club (Iowa Women's State Team Play; August 1), Burlington Golf Club (Iowa Wife Husband; September 8 - 11), and Clarinda Country Club (Iowa Forever 39 Match Play; September 26 - 27).
