

What is the IWGA?

The purpose of the Iowa Women’s Golf Association is to support and encourage golf for women and girls in Iowa and to provide scholarships for educational purposes for Iowa girls to attend Iowa institutions of higher learning.

- The IWGA conducts six major championships throughout the summer. In addition, the IWGA co-conducts the State Parent-Child Championship with the Iowa Golf Association
- The IWGA provides scholarships for Iowa high school seniors who are planning to attend Iowa institutions of higher learning.
- The IWGA publishes a directory of women’s tournaments and golf events for the state of Iowa
- The IWGA is sanctioned by the United States Golf Association to provide women’s course ratings for golf courses in Iowa
